TITLE: Commercial Law

CODE: ADM 201

PREREQUISITE: N/A

CREDITS: 3 credits | 45 contact hours | 1 term

DESCRIPTION

This course studies the fundamentals and general concepts of commercial law necessary to work in the field of Business Administration stemming from the constitutional bases applicable to Puerto Rico. It focuses on the study of the person, the sources of obligations and property, from the perspective of how they affect the exercise of commerce and business. It also introduces the fundamental aspects of commercial law, both from the local, interstate, and international trade perspectives. The course references the legislation and jurisprudence of Puerto Rico and the United States.

JUSTIFICATION

Knowledge of the legal framework applicable to the exercise of commerce is essential for every Business Administration student as it contributes to their professional growth and development. In order to comply with the legal obligations that affect the professional performance of the entrepreneur and/or professional associated with the business, it is essential to know the provisions of the applicable laws and regulations; to be aware of the legal implications of the decisions to be made; to be able to exercise due foresight and caution when acting; and to anticipate the consequences and obligations associated with the agreements, both from a national and international perspective. This course provides the participant with the sources, scenarios, and minimum experiences to acquire the critical judgment that the business professional must develop.

After completion of the course, students will be able to:

- 2. Interpret the sources of law and contracting in general, as well as how they affect decisions in the business world.
- 3. Identify scenarios of liability for acts or omissions in professional performance.
- 4. Apply basic legal provisions that regulate commercial relations in the jurisdiction of Puerto Rico, in its relationship with the federal government of the United States, and in the global environment.
- 5. Recognize the essential fundamentals of an investigation applied to the establishment and/or cessation of a business.
- 6. Value the ethical and social responsibility element in commercial law.
