TITLE IX

Federal law that offers protection against sex discrimination or harassment



What is Title IX?

A federal law that provides protection to students victims of harassment, sexual harassment and sexual assault on or off campus, in any academic, educational, extracurricular and athletic activity supported by the institution.



What does Title IX requires?

Educate the university community on the rules and policies against discrimination of a sexual nature.





Compliance

- Compliance with Title IX is a requirement for education institutions that receive federal funding.
- Educational programs must be developed in compliance with Title IX.
- Take necessary measures to avoid the discrimination and its consequences.
- The Institution have to enact procedures to suit any complaint.
- All higher education institution that benefits from federal funds must have a Title IX Coordinator.

Functions and Responsibilities of the Title IX Coordinator

- Ensures that appropriate policies and procedures are in place training for Students, Faculty and Staff.
- Universidad del Sagrado Corazón is responsible for conducting adequate, impartial investigations of reports and complaints of sexual misconduct. Title IX coordinator evaluates requests for confidentiality and to provide a safe and nondiscriminatory environment for all students.
- Remedies, including Interim Measures-takes steps to ensure the complainant aware of all available resources.
- Monitoring and Advising Annual climate survey.
- Recordkeeping and as necessary recommends to increase safety measures.
- Guidance conducts workshops and disseminates information on Title IX to raise awareness and educate the university community in order to prevent and eradicate sexual violence on campus.



Course of action

- Once a student or employee who becomes aware of a possible constitutive act of sexual harassment committed against a student, it is his or her responsibility to notify the Title IX Coordinator.
 - The coordinator will investigate the incident and take steps to provide security to the victim.
 - It will implement measurements to end the situation, eliminate a hostile environment harassment and prevent reoccurrence.



Student's rights

A student should contact the Title IX Coordinator or Deputy Title IX Coordinator(s) in order to:

- Seek information about student's rights and courses of action available to resolve report or complaints that involve potencial sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct.
- File a complaint to make a report of sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct.
- Notify the college of an incident or policy or procedure that may raise potencial Title IX concerns.
- Get the informacion about available resources (including confidencial resources) and support services relating to sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct.
- Ask quiestions about College's policies and procedures related to sex discrimination, including sexual misconduct.



Any student, employee, designated volunteer, visitor at campus or parent who has information about an incident or was a witness for one violent incident like sexual harassment, or any else relative, shall report such incident to the Title IX deputy, Title IX Coordinator or designee as soon as possible after observing the incident or receiving the information. Reporting parties unable to report in writing will be provided a scribe to assist in the reporting process.
